## DEANERY SYNOD REPRESENTATIVE REQUIRED:

You will be aware that St. Anne's is part of the wider diocese of Liverpool. We are part of a smaller group within the Diocese of around 17 churches that make up the 'South Liverpool Deanery'. (There are 15 Deaneries within the Diocese). Each church is entitled to have a number of representatives that sit on the Deanery Synod.

The Synod is a group of representatives (and clergy) from each church that make up the deanery. The group has a lot of responsibility and is able to table important discussion and agenda items that can then be taken up at Diocesan level. The group is also kept abreast of the latest developments that come down from the Diocese and Bishops.

At St. Anne's we have 2 spaces that need to be filled on Synod. Those who sit on Synod are automatically elected on to St. Anne's PCC.

This is a hugely important time for the Deanery as there are significant changes being made in the next couple of years with regards to Church structure, governance and finance all of which will impact us at St. Anne's.

It is important that St. Anne's has a voice and is fully represented at Synod meetings.
